


How to search for public roads using the drawing tool

Welcome. You may now search for notices and supporting maps for proposed road closures online. This service will help make consultation easier for the accelerated roads program. You may search by drawing a shape on the map over the area you are interested in.

There are some limitations to this search function: it does not include local Council road closures and you will only be able to view and search notices for roads within the 28 day period from when they are advertised.

How to search

1. Click on 'Draw polygon' and you will see 3 shapes appear on the top right, a star, square and circle. Select one of those shapes and draw a shape over the area you are interested in.
2. The map will show you how many results from the shape you've drawn. Click on the number (the green 3 in the image above located on the map) and you will drop to the table immediately below which is full of the notices within the area you've searched. The notice lists are based on which will submission will expire first, meaning the oldest will appear at the top of the table.
3. You are able to filter your search by hitting the triangle shaped toggle keys on the columns on the table or by typing a keyword in to the text box (such as Walgett) and hitting submit.

- The road description shows you details of the road at a glance to help you identify the road you are interested. Click or tap on the linked road and more detail will appear.
