

Crown Land Management Regulation

JUNE 2017

Regulations are required to support the operation of the Crown Land Management Act 2016 (the Act). The Crown Land Management Regulation (the Regulation) will combine relevant current regulations and new regulation to allow the Act to commence and function appropriately.

Matters covered by regulations

The Regulation will cover a wide range of topics including:

- protection and management of Crown land
- acquisition, sale and vesting of Crown land
- leases, licences, and permits
- rent
- enforcement
- conversions
- fees.

Regulatory impact statement

A regulation impact statement is currently being prepared to accompany the Regulation. The impact statement will identify and assess the direct and indirect costs and benefits of each regulation to ensure it is necessary, appropriate and proportionate to risk. This analysis informs the Regulations and will be provided with the proposed Regulation for public comment prior to the Regulation being finalised.

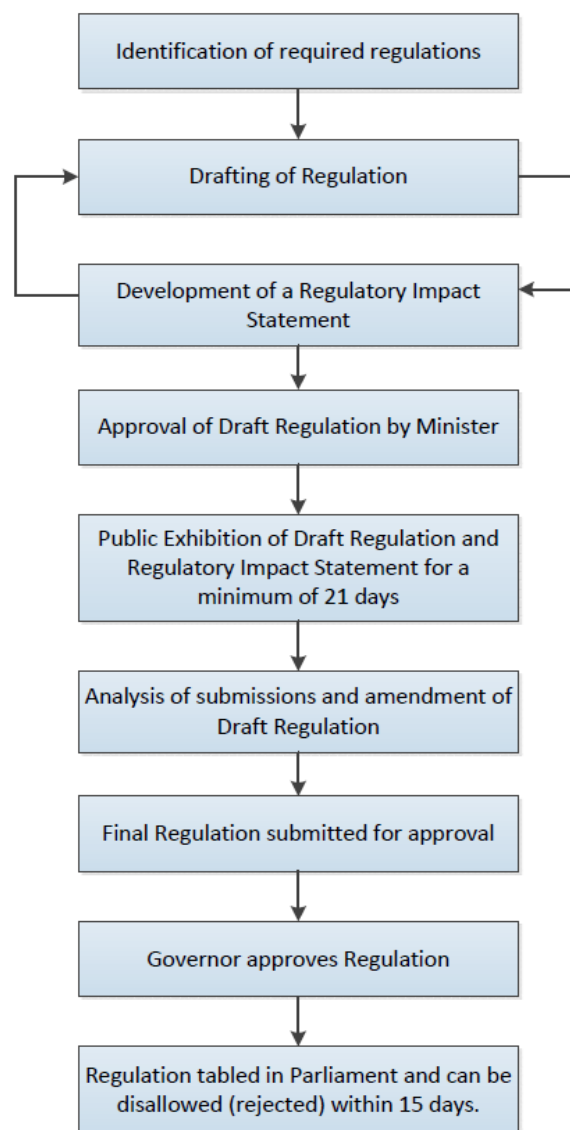


Figure 1 Regulation development process

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
