\$18 MILLION IN CROWN RESERVE FUNDS ON OFFER

Public reserves across NSW will benefit from more than \$18 million in funding, Minister for Natural Resources, Lands and Water Kevin Humphries announced today.

Mr Humphries said the second round of Public Reserves Management Fund Program (PRFMP) will support the development, maintenance and improvement of public reserves throughout NSW.

“Our Crown lands and public reserves are an integral part of the State’s heritage and are highly valued for the part they play in improving the social, economic, environmental and recreational outcomes of our local communities,” Mr Humphries said.

“This new funding will allow crown reserve managers to improve public reserves and ensure that recreational and tourism facilities on them are developed for community use.”

Mr Humphries said the second round of PRMFP is now open for applications and encouraged Crown reserve managers to apply for funding.

“The \$18.7 million in funding that will be allocated in round two is in addition to the more than \$5 million recently announced for successful round one applicants,” Mr Humphries said.

“The second round of the program is open to all Crown reserves, including caravan parks, local parks and reserves, state parks and showgrounds.

“Managers of freehold showgrounds and schools of arts are also eligible to apply.

“The PRMFP is just one example of the NSW Government’s commitment to the cultural, sporting, economic and recreational life of communities across NSW.”

Mr Humphries said Crown reserve managers have until 3 October to submit their applications for round two at www.crownland.nsw.gov.au.
