DREDGING

PRODUCING BALANCED OUTCOMES FOR WATERWAY USE AND MANAGEMENT

- 
- Safe navigation of key river and port entrances is vital for the economy of regional NSW.
 - In many cases, regular dredging is required to ensure safe navigation is maintained.
 - A coordinated and prioritised dredging program delivers on a number of important platforms in the NSW State Plan, including encouraging regional

- economic growth, tourism and community recreation.
- This new strategy supports Lands' development of world-class marine precincts throughout regional NSW in partnership with local councils, communities and businesses including the redevelopment of Batemans Bay Marina, Ulladulla Harbour and the revitalisation of the Nelson Bay foreshore precinct.

- In coordinating an overall response to dredging needs, Lands is working in consultation with stakeholders, including peak industry groups such as the recently established Maritime Access and Infrastructure Council, of which the Boating Industry Association and the Boat Owners Association are members.
