Exhibition of Management Plan for Dangar Falls Reserve

NSW Trade & Investment Crown Lands has announced the exhibition of a revised plan of management for Dangar Falls Reserve.

Dangar Falls is a spectacular tourist attraction situated on Crown land just north of Dorrigo in Northern NSW.

David McPherson, Director East Crown Lands said, "Dangar Falls Reserve has been managed in accordance with a plan that was prepared in 2012. Council has updated the plan so that it provides for the long term needs of the community and visitors."

"Council is now inviting comments on the revised plan which recommends an innovative range of upgrades to improve the public facilities in the recreation and picnic areas, accessibility and car parking. Reserve information and interpretive signage will enhance the tourism experience and add to the recreation and natural values of the reserve."
