



INVITATION: URUNGA OLD ANTIMONY PROCESSING SITE  
INFORMATION SESSION

The remediation and rehabilitation of the old antimony processing site is about to commence.

Once remediation and rehabilitation has been completed at the old antimony processing site, the site will be used as public open space.

To ensure that the community have the opportunity to be informed of the process and provide feedback, a Community Liaison Group will be formed and an information session will be held at:

The meeting will include a presentation explaining the background of the site, latest investigations, remediation techniques, and an invitation of input/comment on issues relating to the remediation.

In addition to the meeting, a Community Liaison Group will be formed to provide a forum for regular updates on the remediation process, gather community feedback and address concerns as they arise.

The Community Liaison Group's membership will be comprised of representatives of community groups, environmental groups and local community. The first Community Liaison Group meeting is scheduled for 1 July 2015.
