

# Coffs Harbour Northern Breakwater Pedestrian access to Muttonbird Island

## Breakwater works recommence

Construction work on the upgrade to Coffs Harbour Northern Breakwater will recommence on 18 April with the closure of the breakwater to the public.

This will allow the removal of the infrastructure that was put in place over the Christmas holidays including the safety fences, temporary Hanbars (large concrete blocks that weigh up 12 tonnes each) that were put up to make the breakwater safe during that period of public access.

Once site preparations have been completed, the

delivery of the rocks for the breakwater will be begin which is expected to be towards the end of April.

## Pedestrian access to Muttonbird Island

Final preparations are underway to finish the boardwalk and allow pedestrian access to Muttonbird Island while the upgrade to the breakwater is completed.

The alternate pedestrian access to Muttonbird Island is shown on the map below.
