### BUILDING CRUISE DESTINATIONS

- Lands is a member of the NSW Cruise Coordination Committee, chaired by Tourism NSW.
- The main objectives of the committee are to:
  - consolidate and build on Sydney's popularity as a premier cruise destination
  - position locations in regional NSW as cruise destinations
  - support other shipping such as super yachts and military

vessels in Sydney and regional NSW.

- The cruise sector is the fastest growing form of tourism throughout the world.
- The NSW Government recognises the benefits the cruise sector can have for tourism in this state and the associated economic boon for local communities along the coast.

- Over last summer, seven cruise ships of varying size visited the port of Eden on the South Coast, which is managed by Lands. The ships generated almost \$500,000 to the local economy through on-shore visits to local attractions. On average each passenger spent \$150.
