I object to the leasing of this crown land for proposed increase of recreational aviation including scenic helicopter flights. This land is in the midst of world heritage wilderness and should be included into the existing national park to maintain the reputation of the magnificent Blue Mountains as a peaceful and quiet getaway and place to live.

As a resident of Blackheath I am already negatively impacted by the increased noise coming from increased road and rail freight trains. The addition of helicopter noise would impact the livability and tourist appeal of the upper Blue Mountains generally as well as impact my personal life and business substantially. I am highly concerned about the impact of this kind of noise on the many tourism businesses in the Blue Mountains marketing a wilderness retreat experience which the Blue Mountains has always been unique in offering in the Sydney region. This area is so special and the impact of this kind of recreational aviation could be disastrous on the experience of living and visiting the Blue Mountains. This lease is not in the best interests of the Blue Mountains environment, small business or residents and can't be justified.

The native wildlife of the area are precious and with so many other threats to wildlife in the present day, the addition of helicopters can not be considered safe or appropriate. No regulations imposed can make this safe - helicopters are known to be a significant hazard to birds, mammals, and vegetation.

The Blue Mountains national park should remain a place where people can escape aviation noise not endure it (and it's echos through the cliffs and valleys). Since we're talking about an airport – the "site" by definition should include any surrounding areas affected by this application. I am a the site that may be impacted by the resident of Medlow Bath. I live and work within the suburb. I currently enjoy the relative tranquillity of living in a small hamlet that is not overrun with tourists or tour operators.

I moved to the Blue Mountains to live in peace and tranquillity, not to suffer sound and air pollution on a daily basis. I enjoy sharing this delicate World Heritage ecosystem with native birds and other animals and would not want their welfare jeopardised by constant machine noise and petroleum emissions. I do not want helicopters or fixed wing aircraft flying anywhere near Medlow Bath or over the Megalong and Kanimbla valleys, as both are in constant use by native birdlife. These you currently use or enjoy the site? : valleys are peaceful and beautiful to look at. Helicopters are not. Furthermore the sound generated by aircraft flying through these areas creates loud echoes from the surrounding valley walls - thus we hear them long before they arrive and for a considerable time after they leave.

> The proposed airport is located within a World Heritage site. The Blue Mountains were granted that prestigious status due to its elemental and pristine beauty. UNESCO have specifically identified "inappropriate recreation and tourism activities including the development of tourism infrastructure, due to increasing Australian and overseas visitor pressure and commercial ventures;" as an ongoing management challenge on their website's Blue Mountains listing. This proposal represents such an expansion of tourist activities. The Blue Mountains risks suffering reputational damage from selling out its greatest assets. It's a false economy to believe that a continual cacophony of buzzing decibels from the privileged few going on joyrides will make the Blue Mountains a more attractive place for the majority of visitors and

residents. The grassroots tourists - backpackers, cyclists, hikers and so on - come here for the space and the peace borne of many thousands of years of nature's handiwork, they don't come to stay next to an aerodrome. Once the character of a wilderness is compromised by over-exposure, decline sets in.

Flyblue have not disclosed many aspects of their operation. For example they have not shared their flight plans, they have merely stated a handful of places they will NOT be flying. They seem to think this is enough. It is not. Surely if they know where they're not flying then by default they know where they are flying? To say otherwise comes across as disingenuousness. Unless they can be completely transparent on this point how can we possibly judge whether their promises have a factual basis? Flyblue's procedures note taking readings at Hampton Wind Farm – which indicates they do intend flying over the Megalong Valley. Residents of Delmonte Ave, Bellevue Crescent and guests at the Hydro Majestic MUST be included in the residential areas FlyBlue have promised to avoid. I did not buy my property to watch and listen to helicopters! Flyblue also say "there is no existing evidence of studies undertaken to-date that would confirm that aviation has any impact on the migratory/breeding patterns, wellbeing, or otherwise of native birdlife." This is NOT proof that the birdlife will not be impacted by their activities. Where is their evidence demonstrating that there will be no adverse impacts? To simply say something must be safe because no one has proven it isn't is a poor sort of logic. The Greenfleet carbon offset program to which Flyblue subscribe is a commendable venture. I fully support the prospect of replenished forests. However unless the promised one tree per flight is planted near to or within the Blue Mountains it is hard to see how our area benefits. A cynic might wonder if this is merely an effort to win over ecologists whilst doing little for the immediate environment within which the commercial activity occurs. Although it may seem churlish to complain I would rather know that the trees are being planted locally, near to the source of the pollution for which they are intended to assuage. It has been noted that other aircraft may use the airport. More information should be provided about this intended use of the airport. Can the restrictions Flyblue say their fleet will abide by be guaranteed for any other operator using the facilities? If not then this use should be limited to emergency flights only. I am concerned that there may be a financial incentive for Flyblue to open up the airport to all comers. The Deerubbin Local Aboriginal Land Council land claim lodged in July 2019 should be assessed and a decision delivered prior to any long term lease being offered to Flyblue or anyone else. The land is Crown land, yet this proposal represents only the commercial interests of private individuals. I would prefer the airport be integrated into the Blue Mountains National Park, with ongoing provision for emergency air support, for cases such as fire-fighting and emergency landings only. More consultation is necessary before any firm decisions should be made.
