We thoroughly enjoy the peace and tranquility that the national park offers, the serene landscape and how readily one can access remote areas by descending into the valleys.

The proposed lease of the Katoomba airfield to a commercial operator will result in dozens to hundrets of aircraft flights (small planes or helicopters) every day in high season, and hence project an immense noise level into the surrounding areas. As the NP is so widely spread, and valleys will reflect the aircraft noise, the experience to all groundbound visitors will be seriously impacted by the noise, making it less appealing to find tranquility and a sense of remoteness. After all, the mountains are welcoming everyone to explore the area by foot, bike, or motorised vehicles along the many roads spreading across the plateau. I can not overstate how utterly damaging the noise of lowflying aircrafts would have to the qualities that make this national park so unique. This is not an appropriate question given the nature of concerns and the current lack of public access to the site. The current airfield does not have public access and hence I do not use or 'enjoy the site'. My concern is the negative impact of the proposed commercial heli-tourism development at this site on the surrounding areas, wildlife, communities and tourist pursuits which focus on enjoying the World Heritage environment. I live in an area which is directly under the flight path and hence would be impacted by noise created by heli-tourism operations. I chose to invest my life earnings in a residence located in a quiet and peaceful environment and the proposed development of a heli-tourism business would threaten if not destroy this.

This is not an appropriate question given the nature of concerns. The current airfield does not have public access and hence I do not use or 'enjoy the site'. My concern is the negative impact of commercial helicopter tourism operations on the surrounding communities, wildlife and World Heritage Area. I do not wish to see an increase in low altitude air traffic, particularly helicopters, which will create significant noise pollution. This will adversely impact upon the residents of our local communities, wildlife, existing tourism and the enjoyment of the peace and quiet of the surrounding natural environment. Furthermore, I reside in the Megalong Valley under the current and proposed flight path and would be directly impacted by commercial heli-tourism and

increased flights. I strongly oppose any development of this nature, particularly as the developers are unwilling to provide any information regarding the scope of operations, frequency of flights etc. Given the lack of information and transperancy specifically relating to scope of operations, I have to assume it would be an intrusive development which will benefit only the operators and be to the detriment of many. Given the proposed investment in infrastructure I believe the scope of operations would need to be significant to make it viable. Once again, an inappropriate question. The community concerns are not about the site but the impact of the proposed development on the surrounding areas and people. A flight height of 500 feet would mean that helicopter flights could be conducted below the escarpment / cliff line amplifying the impact of noise on residents in the valleys and on escarpments. I believe the current airfield should be maintained to serve the greater good of the population of the Blue Mountains area. Both bush-walking and meditation activities would be negatively impacted due to low flying aircraft noise. I had done similar work before so could see what it was they were supposed to be doing, they did not do it. After repeated complaints over a two year period to Endeavour Energy and to the local MP it was brought under control. That was brief summary of the trouble I experienced and the amount of recording, telephoning and emailing I had to do. THE POINT OF ALL THIS IS THAT HELICOPTERS ARE A TERRIBLE NOISE MAKER AND THEY CAN HOVER FOR LONG PERIODS IN ONE SPOT AND FLY WHERE EVER THEY LIKE. The actions of helicopter pilots will not only make residents lives a misery but totally spoil the very peace that tourists and Sydneysiders come to the Blue Mountains for. Some local business people believe that they may get a secondary windfall from these tourists but it is obvious from the flight plans that there will be no STOP OVER for this to happen, it will be very much a fly in fly out operation.

I currently live at an address that is within two hundred meters of the flight path that is proposed for landing. My acoustic privacy will be impacted profoundly from sunrise to sunset seven days a week. I attend meditation retreats at Meadlow Bath that will have acoustic privacy profoundly impacted by this development, not just by the flight path but by the significant increase in traffic to and from the airfield that will pass directly in front of the centre (Blue Mountains Insight Meditation Centre, Rutland Road Meadlow Bath). I frequently go bushwalking in the Grose, Jamison and Megalong valleys all three of which will be impacted heavily by helicopter and fixed wing aircraft noise.

As I live in North Katoomba I would be negatively impacted by the noise of inbound and outbound flights. Since the applicant proposes to conduct flights 7 days per week from first light until just before dark, the noise impact would be UNBEARABLE, not only destroying the relative peace of the local environment and my home, but also having an impact on my health and the value of my property. Small aircraft travelling well north of Minni Ha Ha Falls currently have a significant noise impact on me and other North Katoomba residents, even though they are travelling higher and further away than planes would be flying to and from the proposed Katoomba airstrip.

THe current attitude is a gross overeaction and lack of realistic understanding of the real noise generated by small helicopters of the type mostly used for tourism. Unlimited Railway and traffic noise is likely to continue to be far more intrusive than limited helicopter noise -shall we limit those modes as well ??? Helicopter usage will be always limited by its cost and other limitations such as weather so it is likely flight numbers will be constrained in any event but notwithstanding I agree that initially at least there should be a ceiling on the number of non emergency helicopter flights daily but not on fixed wing flights. Operating hours and minimum operating heights should likewise be fixed as should flight paths of ingress and egress over non residential areas which I believe the operators have already indicated such is their intention. Helicopter usage for tourism and scenic flights is increasing everywhere, Hawaii, Queenstown, Heli Skiing.etc etc the list is endless except in China where the regime wont allow it for internal security reasons. Helicopter usage will be always limited by its cost and other limitations such as weather so it is likely flight numbers will be constrained in any event but notwithstanding I agree that initially at least there should be a ceiling on the number of non emergency helicopter flights daily but not on fixed wing flights. Operating hours and minimum operating heights should likewise be fixed as should flight paths of ingress and egress over non residential areas which I believe the operators have already indicated such is their intention. Helicopter usage for tourism and scenic flights is increasing everywhere, Hawaii, Queenstown, Heli Skiing.etc etc the list is endless except in China where the regime wont allow it for internal security reasons. If Helicopter flights are prevented from operating out of Katoomba airfield then those looking to use same will operate from outside the area without any controls whatsoever also excluding any economic benefit to the BMCC LGA as those tourists wont visit the area. > Should commercial activity at the airfield expand, I am concerned that the level of noise will have a detrimental impact on courses run at the Dhamma Bhumi centre. The tranquility of the grounds at Dhamma Bhumi are critical to the experience meditation students enjoy. The practice of Vipassana meditation demands withdrawl from outside influences; students maintain silence amongst themselves for 10 days, with no access to internet, phone or any other external influences. The aim of this practice is to remove as many distractions as possible, enabling meditators to increase the concentration of their practice. Dhamma Bhumi already suffers some noise from the rail transport nearby. Having the noise of helicopters flying over multiple times a day would significantly diminish the site's effectiveness as a place of retreat. As a nature-lover, I am also concerned about the effects of noise pollution on native bird populations. Whilst the airfield's use by emergency services is vital and absolutely appropriate, given the landscape's susceptibility to bushfire - I have grave concerns about the commercial expansion of airfield services. > I carried out a tree survey of the site in 2016. The plant communities of the site sport a diverse mixture of native fauna that uses the area for foraging and nesting. This includes species like the Yellow-tailed black cockatoo.

The development of the area for commercial use will cause destruction of native bushland, loss of habitat will put added pressure on the native fauna population in the area. The ongoing noise created by the aircraft will also disturb existing fauna populations. The replanting of trees does not recreate the biodiversity that already exists across the area.

The site should be transferred to the national park. The Blue Mountains National Park is already under increased pressure from tourism and the plan to raise the Warragamba Dam wall. The national park is the last refuge for flora and fauna. The buffer areas within and around the national park need to be protected.

In my profession as an **order order**, I have been involved in assessing thousands of trees growing on hundreds of proposed commercial development sites. Despite my attempts to achieve a balance between the needs of the development and retention of some trees, without exception, the clearing is always greater than needed because of the lack of value placed on the natural environment. These areas are part of the buffer to the national park. The intrusion by more developments with the further clearing of native bushland, noise pollution and increased human activity for profit should be weighed up against the impact on the natural environment of the area. All I have seen over the last 6 years is relentless land clearing across NSW and the slow death by a thousand cuts of the natural environment.
