As the world begins to recognise the need to conserve fossil fuels, to limit air pollution and limit greenhouse gases, it is inappropriate to introduce such a wasteful use of resources. Safety Light aircraft and helicopters are among the most accident prone of aircraft. Frequent aircraft movements with lots of take-offs and landings will increase the probability of an accident in the Blue Mountains. History of the airport site and previous commitments The Katoomba Airport site was originally part of the National Park, and was subsequently excised. NPWS 'agreed to exclude the airfield from land to be added to the national park at that time provided that the land was added to the National Park upon the expiry of the lease in 1988'. The then Lands Department agreed to this process. (DLWC March 2000, p45). NPWS expressed interest to Dept for land to be added to the National Park Lease was extended for a further 20 years because of the perceived importance of the airfield to the region. The agreement to incorporate land into The National Park was not honoured. A commercial lease granted to Katoomba Airfield Pty Ltd, up to 2008. In the period1992-95 Helicopter joy flights were operated over the National Park from Airfield. As a result of a community campaign, extra EPA licence conditions were imposed in Dec 1995. As a result, joy flights were discontinued and have not operated since. In 1999-2000, BMCC & NPWS supported the Airfield being incorporated into the National Park. The Dept of Land and Water Conservation report (March 2000) recommended transfer the land to NP In 2008, the commercial lease expired, and the NSW Government proposed sale of the land. BMCC reaffirmed its position of land to NP, opposing private lease & sale of land. In 2017, NPWS reaffirmed interest in obtaining the site. Dept Lands acknowledged agreement that "the land would be returned to the Park" (letter to CASA). The Dept of Industry the called for EOI from parties interested in lease or licence, but NPWS was not invited to submit a case. There is clearly a long history of public desire and intention to transfer the airport to National Parks. This public desire, echoed by the Council, is being frustrated by the Government's current proposal. Conclusion There has been a longstanding intention to transfer the airport site to National Parks, and that is still the wish of the vast majority of residents. The operation of light aircraft and helicopters is noisy, dangerous and causes air pollution. It is a significant contributor to greenhouse gases and global warming. The circulation of low flying aircraft over the natural wonders of the Blue Mountains actually detracts from the very thing that people are coming to see. While such flights may give a few people spectacular views of the Mountains, they will spoil the experience of many more people, who just want to enjoy nature peacefully. The likely employment benefits mentioned by the proponent are likely very small, and more jobs could be lost by the adverse effects of disturbing the environment that currently attracts the visitors. We therefore oppose

this proposal, and believe that the airfield should be maintained by NPWS as an emergency airfield.

I would describe the experience of bushwalking and visits to lookouts as 'majestic silence.' It is a profound and spiritual experience to enjoy the immensity of the National Park and to allow the peacefulness to have its impact. In the company of others, I have also found the relative silence to be a special gift of the mountains.

Whatever is decided, please let the relative tranquility of the Blue Mountains be respected and honoured as a heritage gift to which many generations have contributed, including those of the Darug and Gundungurra peoples. Governments have also shown great foresight by protecting such a wonderful place. Do not betray that heritage.

I do not actually use the old Katoomba Airstrip site, but live relatively close to the site and feel that the Blue Mountains World Heritage National Park and mountain residents and visitors I would be negatively impacted by the proposed development of the airstrip for fixed wing and helicopter tourist flights was to be approved.

As I live in North Katoomba I would be negatively impacted by the noise of inbound and outbound flights. Since the applicant proposes to conduct flights 7 days per week from first light until just before dark, the noise impact would be UNBEARABLE, not only destroying the relative peace of the local environment and my home, but also having an impact on my health and the value of my property. Small aircraft travelling well north of Minni Ha Ha Falls currently have a significant noise impact on me and other North Katoomba residents, even though they are travelling higher and further away than planes would be flying to and from the proposed Katoomba airstrip.

The Katoomba airstrip is surrounded by World Heritage listed national park. To allow regular commercial use of this airstrip would disrespect the precious values of our national park - destroying the peace and tranquility of nature and polluting this precious place.

During serious bush fires and other emergencies in the mountains, the airstrip is an invaluable resource and I fully support the continued use of the airstrip for emergency purposes. I do NOT support the use of this
