## Storing items on foreshore Crown land



Crown Lands is responsible for ensuring that public access to and enjoyment of waterfront land is not restricted.



Storing items such as recreational craft, outdoor seating, materials or equipment on foreshore Crown land is not permitted.



Stored items can obstruct public access to and along the foreshore and can also pose a risk to public safety leading to injury.



Stored items can be an eyesore and spoil the beauty of the surrounding natural areas, waterways and parks reducing community and public pride.



Storing items on public land also places them at risk of theft or damage. To reduce risk, store personal items on your own property.



Storing items on foreshore Crown land may incur a penalty of \$220 for individuals and \$440 for corporations.

If you have any items stored on public land without authority, please remove them so that our valuable foreshores can be enjoyed by everyone.
